



IMPORTANT MEMBER ANNOUNCEMENT!

Dear Member,

At St Johns Park Bowling Club Group (SJPBCG), we are committed to ensure the health and safety of our members, guests, trade personnel and staff. **We have not had any confirmed cases of COVID-19 at our venues.** We are taking the current situation very seriously and as the COVID-19 situation in Australia develops, we will continue taking precautionary action.

The SJPBC Group at all our venues have implemented several additional measures to ensure your health and safety remains a priority when dealing with the (COVID-19) outbreak.

At this point in time, all the SJPBC Group venues are open for business. We are committed to ensuring a clean and hygienic environment within all our venues. By doing so we have implemented the following measures:

HYGIENE AND HANDLING

- Increased signage to encourage personal hygiene throughout all SJPBC Group venues.
- Increased and ongoing staff training to ensure the new hygiene measures are always effective.
- Installation of additional hand sanitise/wipe dispensers located throughout all venues. (especially in high traffic areas)
- Additional hours added to cleaning /hygiene services as well as additional cleaning contractors.
- The introduction of additional food/beverage handling processes within our food and beverage operations.
- Encouragement of Tap & Go payments to avoid cash exchange.
- Cancellation/postponed of all gatherings/events of 500+ people or events/gathering we believe would be high risk at all SJPBC Group venues.

BOWLS – ALL SJPBC GROUP VENUES

- We have today considered advice from Bowls Australia and a joint advice from Women's Bowls NSW and Bowls NSW. As a result, the following now applies effective immediately at all SJPBC Group venues offering the sport of Lawn Bowls.

All bowls events are suspended for an indefinite period. This includes all association events, competition events, Club events and tournaments, social and or barefoot bowls as well as training.

Greens at all SJPBC Group venues will be open for rollups. It is advised that any rollup carried out by members is your decision and no responsibility will be taken by the SJPBC Group. We would ask that if you do choose to participate in a rollup that you take all precautions in reference to safety and hygiene to protect yourself and others. It is also requested that you don't rollup in any group in excess of (4) four persons.

During this time, Bowls Office resources (staff) at all SJPBC Group venues may be limited, if at all.

All golf activities will continue as normal at this stage.
