Nominations for the following Board Positions will be accepted between 9.00am-5.00pm Friday 25 September to Thursday 1 October 2020.

- Treasurer (1)
- Ordinary Directors (6)

Eligible Members* can obtain a Candidate Nomination Pack from either the Future Director Information Session (28/09/20) or Reception of SJPBC between (25/09/20 to 1/10/20). Current Club Membership must be produced to receive a Candidate Nomination Pack.

LODGEMENT OF NOMINATION FORM

Nomination Forms must be lodged (in a sealed envelope to the St Johns Park Bowling Club Secretary – David Marsh) no later than 5.00pm Thursday 1 October 2020.

PLEASE NOTE: Withdrawal of submitted Nomination Form or any amendments to a Nomination Form is not permissible following close of nominations.

Nomination Forms must be signed by the Candidate* and a minimum of two (2) Nominators*; and include the following completed and signed documents:

1. Statutory Declaration (last page) of the Club's Code of Conduct for Directors; must also be certified by a Justice of Peace.
2. Candidate Profile Form inclusive of one (1) colour passport sized photograph.

PLEASE NOTE: Details supplied on Nomination Form will be displayed at both St Johns Park Bowling Club (SJPBC), Tuncurry Beach Bowling Club (TBBC) and Wallacia Country Club (WCC) during the Election period.

BALLOT DRAW

Should more than the required number of Nominations be received, a Ballot Draw will be conducted by Election Solutions to determine the order of Candidate Names on the Ballot Paper.

The Ballot Draw will take place at 10.00am Wednesday 7 October in the Foyer of SJPBC with a minimum of six (6) Members present. Candidates and/or their representatives are invited to witness the Ballot Draw.

VOTING

If an election is necessary, voting will be conducted at SJPBC, TBBC and the WCC during the period Friday 23 October 2020 to Thursday 29 October 2020 as per the voting timetable.

Life, Full Playing and Club Members who are financial as at 5.00pm Thursday 1 October 2020 are eligible to vote. Current Club Membership must be produced to receive a Ballot paper.

NB: The method of voting will be First Past the Post using numbers, members must adhere to instructions on the ballot paper supplied.

NB: Balmain Bowling Club (BBC) members will be required to either attend the SJPBC and/or the TBBC and/or the WCC to vote during the voting period.

* Eligible Candidates and/or Nominators must be Life or Financial Full Playing Members who "ordinarily reside within a radius of 150 kilometres from the Club's premises at St Johns Park"; and must have "at least three (3) years continuous membership of the Club as a Full Playing Member" (Refer to Club Constitution Rules 57 (c) & 58 (a)).
